As President & CEO of thyssenkrupp Bilstein, Schmahl has earned extensive recognition for his commitment to his employees, community and the manufacturing industry. Under his leadership, thyssenkrupp Bilstein has been recognized as a Top Workplace in 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 by Enquirer Media and Best Workplace in 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 by Business Courier. In 2015 and 2017, Butler County Board of Developmental Disabilities voted thyssenkrupp Bilstein of America Employer of the Year.

So, we invest in the expansion of our training and development programs and enable thyssenkrupp Bilstein employees learn new skills and pursue new opportunities throughout our organization.

In terms of recruiting the best talent, we try to be proactive, creative and open-minded. We currently work with several universities to recruit and offer scholarships to students. This work helps promote and further interest in the fields of engineering, logistics and supply chain management among the future workforce. We partner with local high schools to offer seniors apprenticeship opportunities that combine on-the-job learning with industry certification. Another great win-win for us has been our partnership with the Butler County Board of Developmental Disabilities. We currently have 18 full-time employees with disabilities on our staff, and they are all doing an exceptional job and are an incredibly valuable segment of the workforce.

What advice would you give someone coming into the industry?

Get involved in Industry 4.0. The manufacturing industry is at a tipping point and we are at the start of the next great industrial revolution. Industry 4.0 is disrupting old business models and creating new, exciting career pathways where you can advance your career quickly and keep your skills fresh.
